## Hinton FC Team wear

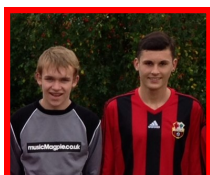
- New Hinton team wear is now available to purchase. The first time a while this has been available to be worn to club events and pre matches.
